JOBSONS BREAD SERVICE

The annual Samuel Jobson's Bread Service will take place in All Saints Church at 10.45am on Tuesday 2nd April. The Samuel Jobson's bread charity is one of the few charities, linked to a local Parish Church, that has survived. Jobson was a local man, baptised in 1623 in All Saints and buried there in 1687. He left a bequest that a dole of bread to be distributed at his church each Easter Tuesday. This still happens today and so a small loaf of bread will be given out at the end of the service!
